LIMITED WARRANTY

The Seller warrants its goods (the "Product") against defects in Seller's material and workmanship for a period of ten (10) years after shipment to Purchaser (the "Warranty Period"), subject to the following terms and conditions: (i) the Product must be stored, installed and maintained in accordance with Seller's instructions which accompany the Product, (ii) Buyer shall inspect the Product within ten (10) days after its receipt thereof, and give written notice to Seller of any non-conforming Product within that same time period, (iii) in the event that investigation by Seller discloses that the alleged non-conformity in the Product was not related to the condition of the Product when it left the control of Seller, then Buyer shall pay for all expenses incurred by Seller in the investigation and/or testing of the Product in question; and (iv) Buyer is obligated to pay any outstanding charges owed to Seller prior to the performance by Seller of any warranty obligations which may be due to the Buyer.

The Seller reserves the right to inspect any Product claimed defective under this limited warranty either at the Purchaser's location or at the Seller's plant, if returned, freight prepaid by Seller (subject to reimbursement in accordance with the terms of this limited warranty). During the Warranty Period, any Product with defects due to Seller's material or workmanship will be replaced or repaired free of charge or, at Seller's option, the purchase price will be refunded upon return of the Product. The Seller assumes no liability for labor charges incidental to the adjustment service, repairing, removal or replacement of the Product or other costs, or for the expense of repairs made outside of its factory except when made pursuant to the Seller's prior written consent. The Seller at its option may ship a replacement or replacements immediately under standard billing and make warranty adjustment after inspection of the defective Product by means of a credit memorandum.

The limited warranties by seller and the remedies of buyer set forth above are exclusive and in substitution for (and buyer hereby waives, releases and renounces) all other warranties of seller and rights, claims and remedies of buyer against seller for any other warranty, express or implied, arising by law or otherwise, including but not limited to: (1) any implied warranty or merchantability or fitness for a particular purpose; (ii) any implied warranty arising from course of performance, course of dealing or trade usage. In no event shall seller be liable under this limited warranty or otherwise for any special, consequential or incidental damages, including loss of use or loss of profits by buyer. This is so even if seller has been advised of the possibility of such damages arising out of buyer's business. The limited warranties set forth above are exclusive to buyer, and may not be assigned or transferred to any other party.
